3b	My Relationships	2	What is Child Sexual Exploitation?	Recognise and identify risky situations and factors of sexual exploitation. Understand it's easy to be drawn into sexual exploitation and how difficult it is to get out of. Talk about the emotional and physical impact of sexual exploitation and empathise with others' feelings. Identify key people we could turn to for support, to help keep themselves safe. 3b	My Relationships	5	What is child-on-child abuse?	Understand definitions of a child, and child-on-child abuse. Learn that reported child abuse has increased significantly, and consider reasons for this. Discuss what makes for good relationships. Consider some potentially abusive relationships. Discuss how students feel sexual harassment should be dealt with in schools. Develop skills of respecting others and empathy.	Pol-Ed - KS3 relationships (Yr 7) - Presentation & Workbook
3b	My Relationships	6	What is sexism?	Students learn about the Equality Act, protected characteristics and definitions of sexism and misogyny. Discuss aspects of sexism and how to call it out. Learn about some of the things that our school community could/should do to prevent sexism (and other hate crimes). Develop skills of respecting others and empathy.
